

# Bringing Families Home

*Housing stability for families involved in the child welfare system*

## Program Overview

Bringing Families Home supports families involved in the child welfare system who are experiencing homelessness or housing instability. Stable housing is essential for child safety and family reunification. Through 211 LA, families are screened, referred, and supported through housing navigation and care coordination to help keep families together.

## Who This Program Serves

- Families with active or recent child welfare involvement
- Households experiencing homelessness or housing instability
- Parents working toward reunification

**Service Area:** Los Angeles County

## How People Connect to the Service

- Families are referred through child welfare partners
- 211 LA care coordinators assess housing needs
- Families are connected to housing resources and providers
- Ongoing follow-up supports stabilization and reunification

## Funders & Partners

Bringing Families Home is funded by the Los Angeles County Department of Children and Family Services and implemented in partnership with housing providers and county agencies.

**Bringing Families Home** addresses housing instability as a critical part of family preservation.

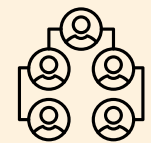
