## Program Overview

The LA Found Hotline supports families caring for individuals at risk of wandering due to Alzheimer's, dementia, autism, or other cognitive impairments. Operated by 211 LA, the hotline helps caregivers enroll loved ones in the Project Lifesaver program and provides immediate support if someone goes missing.

## Who This Program Serves

- Individuals with cognitive impairments
- Family members and caregivers
- Households concerned about wandering and safety

## How People Connect to the Service

- Caregivers and households call 833-569-7651 or 2-1-1
- Staff assist with enrollment and provide education
- If a registered individual goes missing, reports are initiated quickly
- Coordination supports rapid response and recovery
